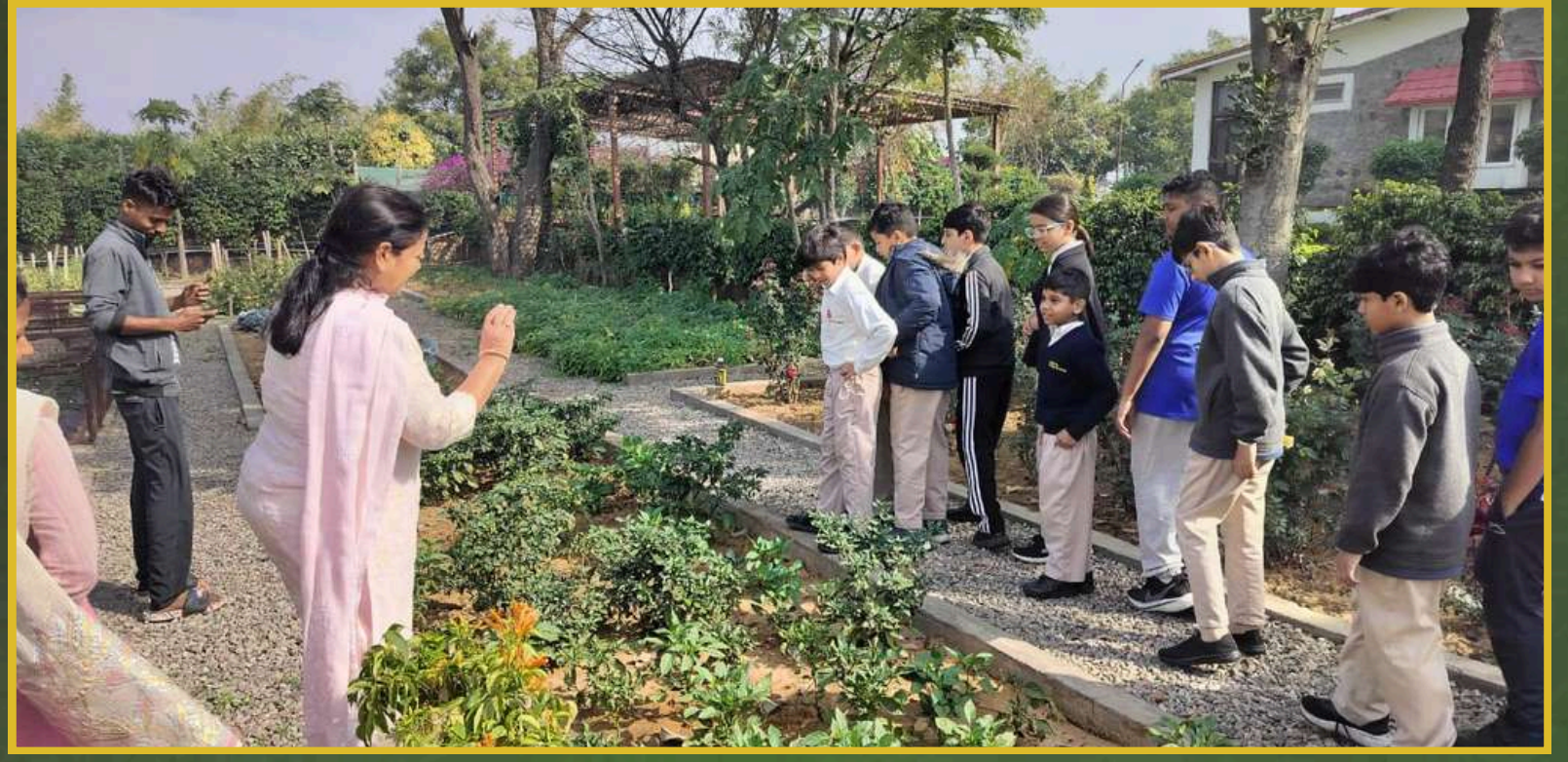

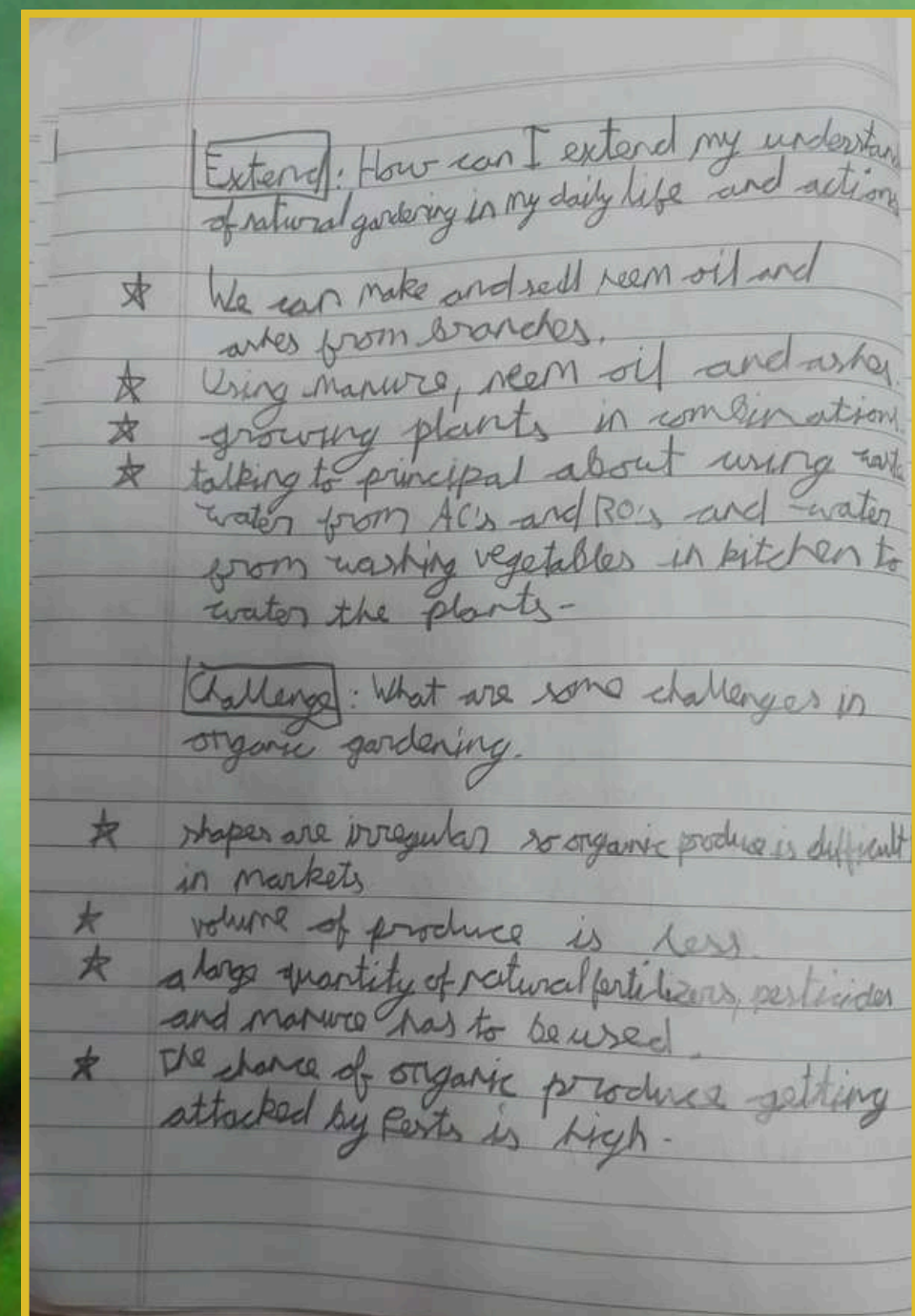
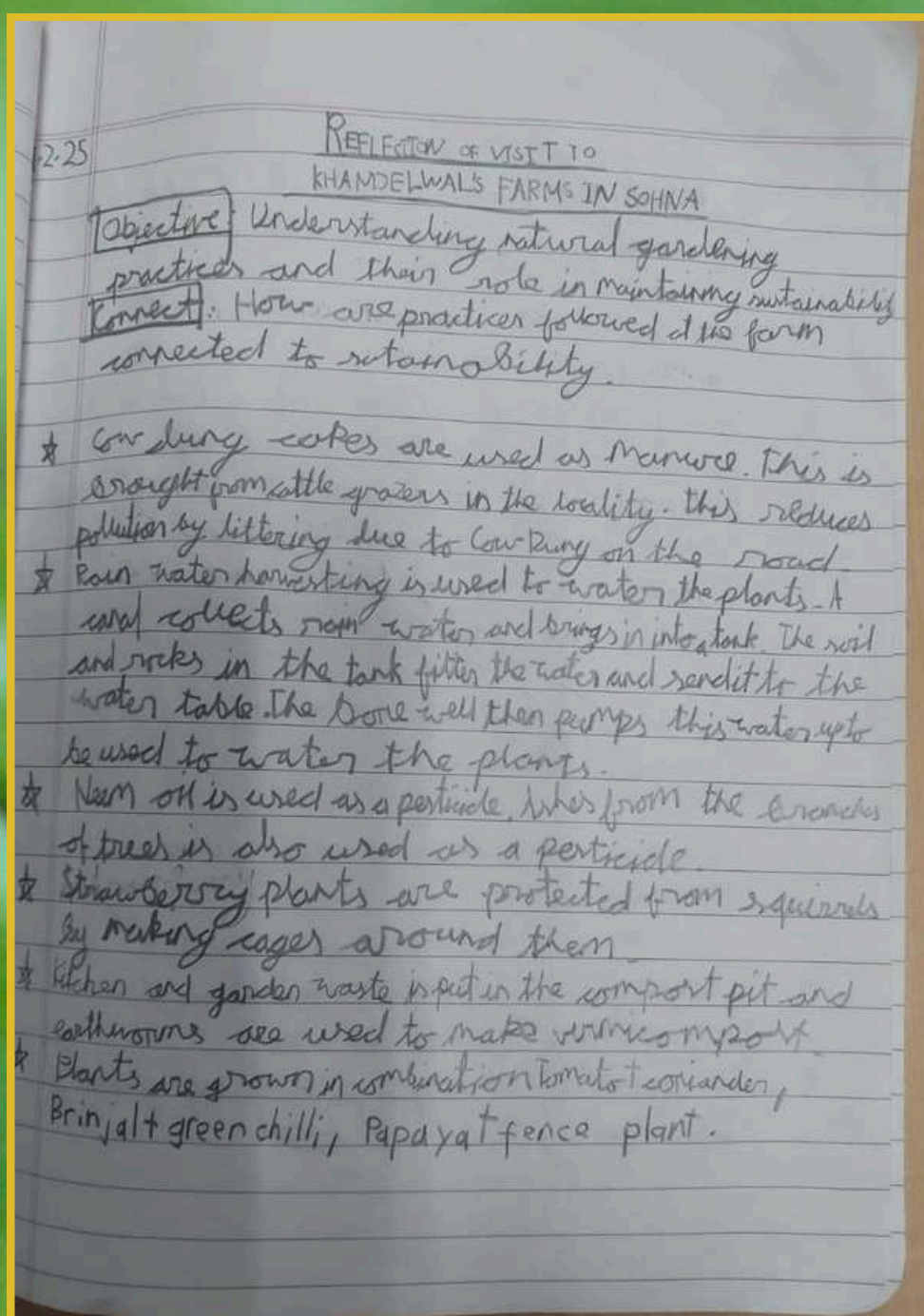




Making connections with the learning
