#### The Ultimate Combat Sport



Fencing is derived from the Latin word for defence. It is a very difficult sport as it challenges both the mind and the body.



- X The fencing suits are white because, in earlier times, touching was recorded with a piece of cotton at the tip of the weapon dripped in ink.
  - $\mathbf{X}$  Many of the ballet positions are derived from fencing.
  - **X** Fencing became an increasingly organized competitive sport late in the 19th century.
  - X One of fencing's most recent developments is wheelchair fencing, which was introduced by German-born English neurosurgeon.
- X Fencing is a <u>combat sport</u> that features sword fighting. It consists of three primary disciplines: <u>foil</u>, <u>épée</u>, and <u>sabre</u> (also spelled saber), each with its own blade and set of rules.
- X You need to hold on to the sword and have good leg work because you are lunging for your opponent trying to score a point. A lot of hand-eye coordination is used as well in the sport which is a tedious task which requires lots of concentration.

#### **SABRE**


Cutting and thrusting, upper body target, aggressive, fastpaced style.

#### **FOIL**

Light thrusting sword:
torso target only,
follows rules
emphasizing technique,
speed, and precision.

#### ÉPÉE

Heavy thrusting and team sport weapon, all body target, strategic and precise.
